Installation detail: T-bar meeting stile seal

It is not necessary to remove the door from its hinges unless otherwise specified.

-
- Step 1** Remove the seal from the packaging and measure the meeting edges of the door leaves to determine the seal lengths required.
-
- Step 2** Pull back the silicone gasket and cut the aluminium meeting stiles to length. Slide the gasket back into position and cut to length.
-
- Step 3** Measure and mark the fixing hole location on stiles. Holes are located on the centre-line of the stiles 50mm down from the top, 50mm from the bottom and at the lock height, avoiding strike and lock plates. (This corresponds with the doors internal reinforcing plates and ensures a good fixing).
-
- Step 4** Drill 4.5mm clearance holes for the fixing screws and countersink so that the screw heads are slightly recessed under the surface of both meeting stiles.
-
- Step 5** Select the inactive leaf and position the flanged meeting stile over the door edge ensuring that the stop is on the correct side and that it is flush top and bottom.
-
- Step 6** With a pencil mark through the fixing holes, remove meeting stile and drill 2.5mm pilot holes through the door lipping and internal steel reinforcing plates.
-
- Step 7** Measure, mark and cut out holes / apertures for lock set and striker plates.
-
- Step 8** Re-position meeting stile and screw fix in place.
-
- Step 9** For fixing of the plain stile, repeat steps 2 to 8.

- Step 10** Check doors operate correctly and that the latch engages in strike.

Important

Australian fire door designs are proprietary by nature and therefore it is a requirement that door seals and other items of essential hardware are tested in accordance with AS1530/4 with each fire door manufacturers' door type to ensure that they do not compromise the assembly's established fire resistance.

Ensure that the installation of this product does not impede the self closing and self latching of the door. Periodic inspection and cleaning is recommended to fully maintain this sealing system.
